

Adjusted net national income per capita (current US\$)

Adjusted net national income per capita is adjusted net national income (NNI) divided by number of people in the country.

Adjusted NNI is Gross National Income (GNI) minus consumption of fixed capital and natural resources depletion.

GNI is the sum of value added by all producers who are residents in a nation, plus any product taxes (minus subsidies) not included in output, plus income received from abroad such as employee compensation and property income.

Contribution to the green economy:

Any economy is designed to generate incomes for citizens for spending on material goods and services, and this indicator measures net incomes in aggregate.

Cost of accessing data:

Potential misinterpretation: That this measures typical household incomes; however it does not include any distributional data.

Related Indicator: [Shared prosperity: median household incomes](#) [18]

Potential misinterpretation: That it adjusted levels of material prosperity, but it includes goods and services designed to correct 'bads' such as environmental pollution, earthquakes and crime. An increase in adjusted net national income per capita caused by example by environmental pollution, does not signify rising prosperity.

Potential misinterpretation: That it always measures economic success: Adjusted NNI is not adjusted by intangible assets.
